PRAGUE NEWS

Recent recordings supervised in Prague by Tadlow Music include:

THE HITTTES

Major new filmed documentary from Turkey, directed by Tolga Ornek, which will receive both a Cinema and TV release. The first major Turkish production to have a symphonic orchestral score. Music Composed by Tamer Ciray. The City of Prague Philharmonic Orchestra and Chorus conducted by Mario Klemens.

GYLCHRIS SPRAUVE

String overdubs arranged by this versatile singer, composer and arranger for the American Christian market.

BOBBY MUZINGO

Film score by Bobby Muzingo recorded with the Prague Studio Symphony Orchestra and the Prague Philharmonic Choir at the studios of Czech TV.

CRAIG ARMSTRONG

The composer of MOULIN ROUGE and THE QUIET AMERICAN visited Prague to record various pieces and demos including a song for TOMB RAIDER II and strings for a YOKO ONO song.

DAVID SANCHEZ - SACD

Legendary Puerto Rican sax player David Sanchez and 6-piece band came to Prague to record their latest album for SONY JAZZ. Music with a Latin American slant by Sanchez, Villa Lobos and Ginastera was recorded with the band playing "live" with the City of Prague Philharmonic Orchestra. This is a prestigious SACD release produced by Sony veteran Steven Epstein and engineered by Todd Whitelock who flew in from New York for the sessions.

DAME SHIRLEY BASSEY

Producer Frank Gallagher and engineer Geoff Foster visited Prague to record strings and choir for the very latest Sony album by Dame Shirley Bassey.

KEITH GETTY

String overdubs by this talented Irish arranger and composer for clients in London and Nashville.

SILVA SCREEN RECORDS.

More recordings of vintage film music produced by James Fitzpatrick including FALL OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE, LAND OF THE PHAROAHS, THE WELL, TARZAN AND THE MERMAIDS, CYRANO DE BERGERAC and CIRCUS WORLD all composed by DIMITRI TIOMKIN and performed by The City of Prague Philharmonic Orchestra and Choir. A group of the Prague Studio Symphony Orchestra with select Jazz soloists recorded various themes including QUINCY, CHARLIE'S ANGELS and MISSION IMPOSSIBLE.
